Appeals 2016 breakdown and 2015-2016 comparative data¹

APPEALS 2016: HEADQUARTERS

The ICRC's appeal for its headquarters amounts to:

CHF 196.5 million

This represents an **increase of CHF 2.3 million (+ 1.2%)** compared with the initial Headquarters Appeal 2015.

APPEALS 2016: OPERATIONS²

The ICRC's appeal for its field operations amounts to:

CHF 1,525.5 million

This represents an **increase of CHF 146.2 million** (+ **10.6%**) compared with the *initial* Emergency Appeals 2015, i.e. the amount initially appealed for, not including budget extensions that occurred during the year.

COMPARATIVE INCREASES AND DECREASES

AFRICA

- → + CHF 56.8 million or + 10% compared with the initial 2015 budget
- ⇒ significant increases include: Nigeria (+ CHF 42.8 million or + 183%); Yaoundé (regional) (+ CHF 11.9 million or + 181%); Niger (+ CHF 8.3 million or + 55%); Sudan (+ CHF 5.7 million or + 114%); Libya (+ CHF 4.3 million or + 46%); Burundi (+ CHF 2.2 million or + 47%)
- → significant decreases include: Liberia (- CHF 11.6 million or 66%); Abidjan (regional) (- CHF 2.3 million or 18%)

AMERICAS

- → CHF 2.2 million or 3% compared with the initial 2015 budget
- → significant decreases include: Haiti (- CHF 2.0 million or 41%)

ASIA AND THE PACIFIC

- → + CHF 19.4 million or + 9% compared with the initial 2015 budget
- → significant increases include: Afghanistan (+ CHF 8.3 million or + 10%); Myanmar (+ CHF 4.9 million or + 17%); Sri Lanka (+ CHF 2.0 million or + 26%)
- → significant decreases include: Nepal (- CHF 0.7 million or 20%)

EUROPE AND CENTRAL ASIA

- → + CHF 21.2 million or + 19% compared with the initial 2015 budget
- → significant increases include: Ukraine (+ CHF 17.5 million or 37%); Moscow (regional) (+ CHF 4.7 million or 39%)
- → significant decreases include: Georgia (- CHF 1.9 million or 18%)

NEAR AND MIDDLE EAST

→ + CHF 51.0 million or + 12% compared with the initial 2015 budget

→ significant increases include: Iraq (+ CHF 41.5 million or + 53%); Yemen (+ CHF 20.5 million or + 71%); Kuwait (regional) (+ CHF 2.2 million or + 45%)

→ significant decreases include: Egypt (- CHF 1.9 million or - 31%)
